

In order to develop friendly relations between Great Britain and the Minsk Radio Engineering Institute of Byelorussia (MREI) the following is agreed:

1. Each side will work together to fulfil the following aims:
 - to prepare and publish books and software on computer related subjects.

AGREEMENT FOR JOINT PROJECTS BETWEEN COMPUTER BOOKSHOPS LTD OF ENGLAND AND THE MINSK RADIO ENGINEERING INSTITUTE OF BYELORUS.

3. CBL shall have first opportunity to consider for publication the books offered by the MREI, in accordance with the additional agreement A. The commercial side of the publication of the books shall be subject to an agreement between the authors and the publishers Wrox Press Ltd of Birmingham England.

4. This agreement is valid for 12 months from date of signing. Subject to the satisfactory completion of previous joint projects, the MREI and CBL shall complete a further agreement such as this on joint projects every 12 calendar months.

5. Where possible, MREI and CBL shall notify each other of relevant conferences being held in their respective countries.

6. This agreement does not exclude the possibility of changes or additions to fulfil the aims and tasks of the joint project.

7. The representative of MREI is Professor Valery Sklyatov.
The representative of CBL is the Managing Director, Ian Maclean.




